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# Grama Niladhari Divisions Statistics - 2020

## Matale District

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### Highlights

- ❑ Matale district consists with 11 Divisional Secretariat Divisions and 540 Grama Niladhari Divisions.
- ❑ 171,769 families are registered in election roll while highest percentage (15.2%) is reported from Galewela Divisional Secretariat Division and lowest (3.3%) is reported from Ambanganga Korale Divisional Secretariat Division.
- ❑ Only two Divisional Secretariat Divisions have the ability to use railway station and the boat/ferry jetty providing transport facility is not available within any Divisional Secretariat Divisions.
- ❑ Each and every Divisional Secretariat Division has the facility of one or more government or private hospital. Further 52% of the Grama Niladhari Divisions (facility is not available within the Grama Niladhari Divisions) report 5km or more distance to access the facility of government or private hospital.
- ❑ Fifteen percent of Grama Niladhari Divisions report that the facility of government or private school which offers classes for A/L is available within the Grama Niladhari Divisions. The facility of government or private school which offers classes for O/L or below grades is available within 41% of the Grama Niladhari Divisions.
- ❑ Solid Waste Disposal Systems provided by local government is available in only 67 (12%) Grama Niladhari Divisions.
- ❑ Pipe borne water from National water supply or community base organization is available in 342 (63%) Grama Niladhari Divisions
- ❑ Wood (18%), textile & textile handicrafts industries (15%) and Jewellery making industries (11%) are the most common traditional handicraft industries found in the district
- ❑ Majority of GN Divisions report damage cause by other wild animals fires (42%), drought (41%), wild elephants (29%) and drying of water springs (24%) under disasters happened during last 10 years
- ❑ While majority of the Grama Niladhari Divisions (517,96%) involved in crop productions 47% involved in non-agricultural economic activities 18% involved in livestock and 4% involved in fishery industries.
- ❑ 51,629 "Samurdhi" receivers and 11,394 elderly allowances receivers are reported at the time of data collection.

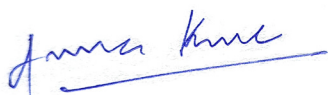
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## Preface

A complete set of statistics on Grama Niladhari Divisions (GNDs) are published once in ten years with the Census of Population and Housing (CPH) conducted by the Department of Census and Statistics (DCS). However, GNDs have undergone a massive social as well as economic changes during the previous ten-year inter-census period, and, therefore, relevant and timely data to capture these changes is vital as a basis for development planning and also for the planning and implementation of the CPH. Therefore, having understood the importance of data for regional level development activities and for CPH 2021, the DCS conducted a collection of basic information on Grama Niladhari Divisions (GNI).

The data gathered in this activity includes information on the availability of basic facilities of the Grama Niladhari Division and the information on infrastructure, consumption of land, Government subsidies, and disaster situations. Data collection was carried out during fourth quarter 2020 and the first quarter of 2021, covering the entire country. Despite the prevailed situation of spreading COVID-19 pandemic throughout the country which occurred during the data collection period, the activity was completed successfully.

This report presents results related to the basic information on Grama Niladhari Divisions in Matale district at Divisional Secretariat level. Detailed information on Grama Niladhari Divisions will be published on Department's website. I believe this report as well as the full dataset will be highly beneficial for evidence-based decision making at any administrative level of the country.

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## 1. Introduction

The GNI-2020 is a census type of data collection conducted during last half of the year 2020 in all around the country in parallel to Census of Population and Housing 2021. This special survey collected various information on Grama Niladhari Division which is the smallest administrative area in Sri Lanka. It covered all 25 districts in Sri Lanka and interviewed or asked to self-report by the officer named "Grama Niladhari (GN)" who is responsible for the particular GN Division. The main objective of this was to build a supportive database which provides basic information by the smallest administrative area for data users. Further, the data was collected on important aspects covering socio and economic related areas. This report presents the summarized statistics on Divisional Secretariat (DS) Division using the data collected at GN Division level for the Matale district. Matale district GNI-2020 data were collected during the fourth quarter 2020. The main themes covered at the data collection were,

- Background information about the immediate responsible officer for the administrative area "Grama Niladhari (GN)"
- Information on the distance to the nearest location where basic facilities are available
- Information on threats (drugs and alcohol) spread over the GN Divisions, availability of handicraft industries and disasters faced during last 10 years
- Information on economic activities (major economic activities involved, major irrigation schemes used and abundant government reservations which can be cultivated)
- Information on availability of facilitating centres for agricultural, livestock & fisheries activities
- Information on the availability of places which provide basic facilities to people
- Information on government beneficiaries for selected types of benefits.

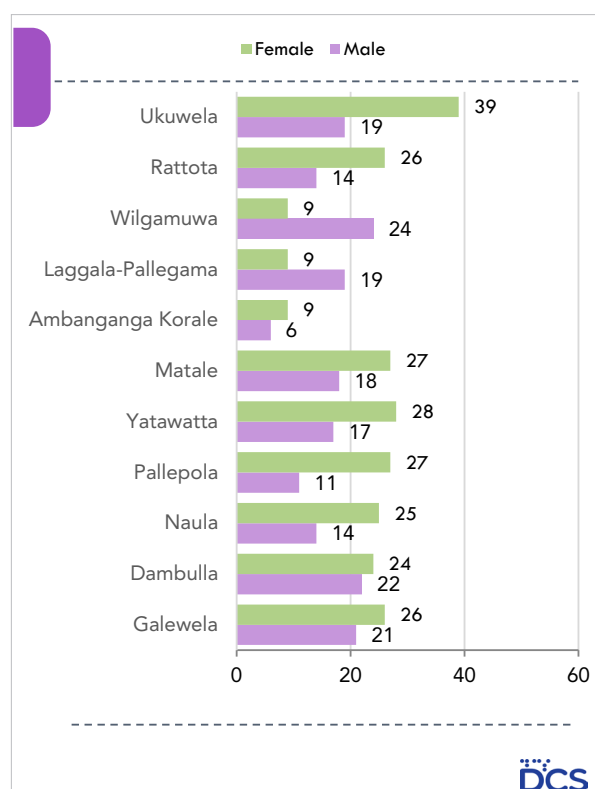
### 1.1 Background information of the Grama Niladhari and Grama Niladhari Divisions

Matale district has 11 Divisional Secretariat Divisions and total number of 540 Grama Niladhari Divisions. As given in Table 1.1 the Ukuwela DS Division has the highest number of GN Divisions (73) while Ambanganga Korale has the lowest number of GN Divisions (20).

As depicted in Figure 1.1 both male and female Grama Niladharis work in every DS Division and the district majority is female officers.

Due to various administrative reasons some GN Divisions may be vacant without a permanent officer. Therefore, a GN who is permanently attached to another division is assigned as an acting officer for a temporary period till the vacancy is filled. Table 1.2 gives the number of GN Divisions by permanent or acting status of the GN in Matale district during the survey period and for each DS Division. It shows that out of 540 total GN Divisions 434 have permanent officers and other 106 function as acting domains. However, number of vacant GN Divisions differ Ukuwela, Rattota, Dambulla, Galewela and Yatawatta show comparatively large number of acting GNs.

The total number of families registered in election roll in the Matale District is 171,769. Among them Galewela DS Division reports the highest number of families (26,160). The lowest number of families are reported from Ambanganga Korale (5,670).

As given in the Table 1.4, 15,647 pensioners reported from Matale District. The highest number of pensioners reported from Matale DS Division (3,678). Laggala-Pallegama reports the lowest number of pensioners which is 1.6 percent (247) of Matale total.

At time of the data collection there are 10,948 'Ranaviru' families and 698 disabled 'Ranaviru' persons in Matale District (Table 1.5). Galewela reports the highest number of 'Ranaviru' families and also the highest number disabled 'Ranaviru' persons. Laggala-Pallegama reports the lowest number of 'Ranaviru' families. Ambanganga Korale reports the lowest number disabled 'Ranaviru' persons.

## 2. Availability of Basic facilities

This section presents the information on the availability of basic facilities within the GN Division and on the distance to the nearest location where the basic facilities are available. Data collects on following six facilities:

- 1. Transport**  
Public transport (bus) start/end destination, railway station, three -wheel park, boat/ferry jetty, road which transport buses/vans/lorries across or near the GN Division
- 2. Health**  
Government or private hospital, government or private dispensary, maternity clinic/baby clinic, MOH's office
- 3. Education**  
Government or private school which offers classes for A/L, government or private school offering classes for O/L, kindergarten/pre-school/early childhood development centre
- 4. Communication**  
Government post office/sub post office or agency post office, Vidhatha Centre/Nena Sala Centre, communication centre
- 5. Facilities provided by Local government**  
Public playground, Children park, Praja Shalawa, Public Library/Reading Room, Cemetery, Marketplace/Fair/Public Store
- 6. Other facilities**  
Branch of government or private bank, Filling station, Police station, DS office, Local government office

The Table 2.1 gives the number of GN Divisions with the transport facility available within the GN division in Matale district. The statistics revealed that public transport bus start/destinations are available in 44 GN Divisions out of total. In addition to that, only 2 GN Divisions have the ability to use railway station within their division. DS division level distribution shows how these facilities are distributed more clearly.

Table 2.2 presents the information on GN Divisions which do not have access to the public transport bus start/end destination within the division. The statistics show the number of GN Divisions by the minimum distance to nearest location of that transport facility available. The survey finds that in 496 GN Divisions, the facility is not available within the GN Division. However, only 274 GN Divisions in Matale district show distance more than 5km to the facility and considerable number of GN divisions except Matale, Ambanganga Korale and Pallepola are there.

Many of the GN Divisions (538 out of 540) in Matale district do not have any railway station within the GN Division. For some DS Divisions railway facility is not relevant (this indicates people in these areas do not consider railway as a regular transport mode due to unavailability of nearby facility).

Three-wheeler is common taxi service in the country and there are allotted parking places for these, where people can get the facility. Many of the GN Divisions (125 GNDs out of 540 GNDs) in Matale district have three-wheel park within the GN Division except Ambanganga Korale, Wilgamuwa, Naula, Laggala-Pallegama and Rattota DS Divisions. However, only 131 GN Divisions reported the distance 5km or more to get the facility.

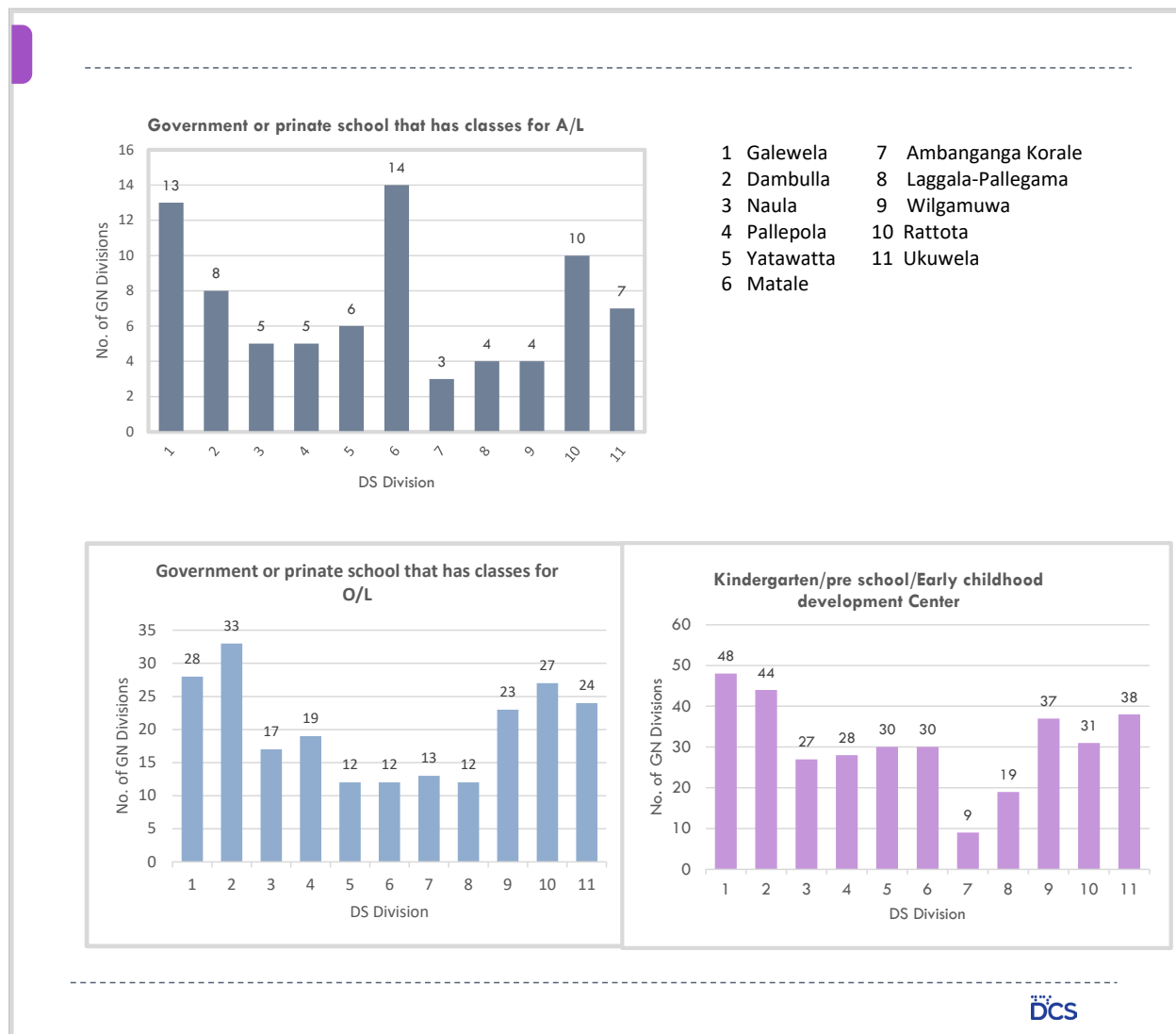

According to the above Table 2.10 and Table 2.11 among 540 total GN divisions 373 GN divisions and 528 GN divisions do not have access to maternity / baby clinics and office of the MOH respectively within the GN Division. Majority of the GN divisions can access the facility of maternity / baby clinics, less than 5 Km. The statistics reveal that 36 GN divisions report more than 5km to access maternity/baby clinic while 349 GN divisions are there with more than 5 km to visit to a MOH office in Matale district. Considerable number of GN Divisions in Dambulla, Ukuwela, Galewela, Rattota and Yatawatta reported MOH office is away 5 or more kilometres.

## 2.3 Education

### Availability of Education Facilities within Grama Niladhari (GN) Division.

The education facilities cover the availability of kindergarten/pre-school/early childhood development centre, government or private school that has classes for G.C.E(O/L) and below and government or private school that has classes for G.C.E(A/L). Following figures show the distribution of number of GN Divisions in which these facilities are available.

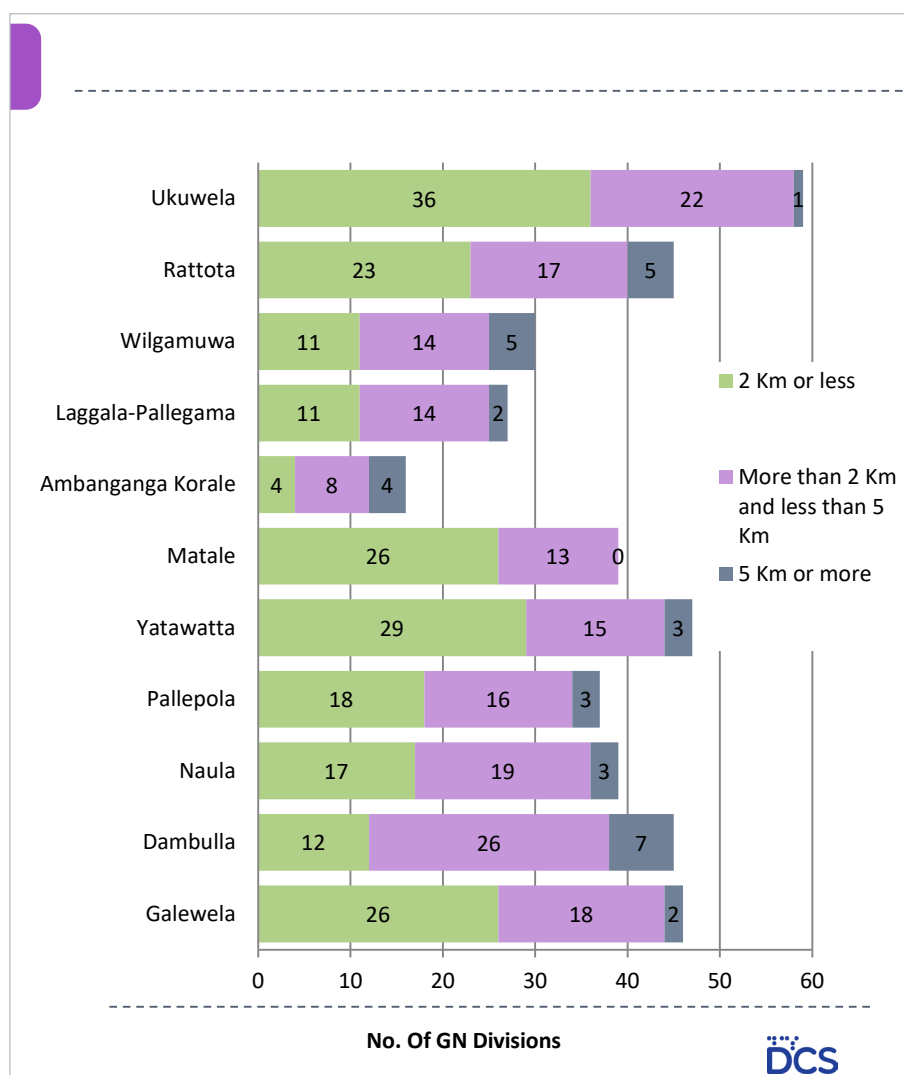

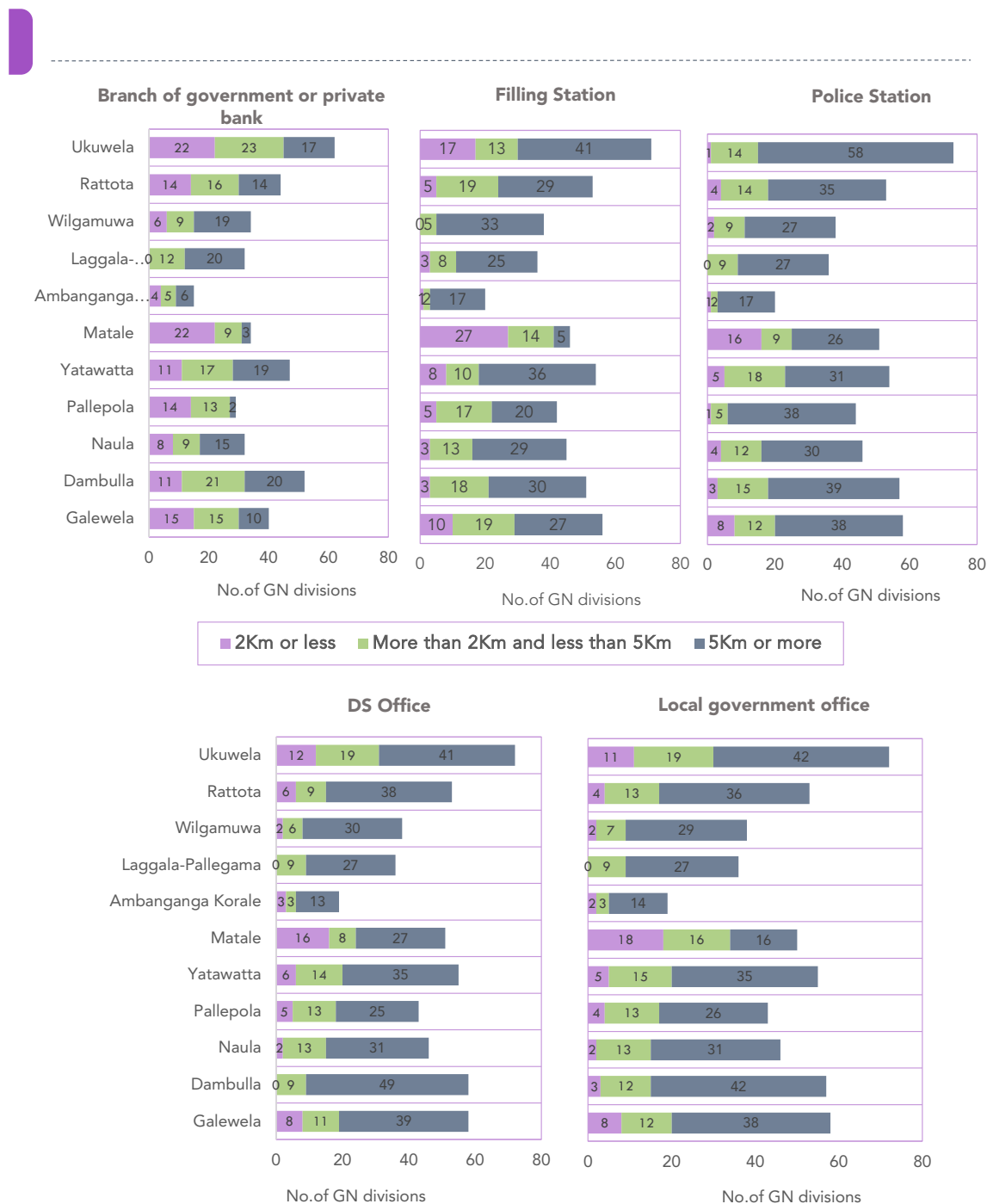

The Table 6.1 shows the aggregated results of the reported major economic activities involved in GN Division, one GN Division may engage in few economic activities. The majority of GN Divisions in Matale reported involving in crop productions. Every DS Division reported more GN Divisions with crop production. Ten types of government benefits were considered at the survey and collected the counts at GN Division level. The above Table 8.1 shows the aggregated number of beneficiaries at DS Division level. Among the beneficiary majority are "Samurdhi" receivers and "Other aid" receives are the lowest. Ambanganga Korale DS Division has the lowest "Samurdhi" recipients while Galewela DS Division has the highest in that category. In Wilgamuwa DS Division "Kidney aids" recipients are comparatively higher. (1132 out of 2310).
